# "SUPER S.T.E.M. SCIENCE ADVENTURES"

#### • Week 1: (July 10 to July 14)

During Super S.T.E.M. Week, campers will explore engineering, simple circuity, magnets, optics, and puzzles and a variety of science related themes and crafts. There will be plenty of hands-on, experiential learning opportunities in addition to our two off-site learning adventures.

Possible field trip destinations include Air and Space Museum, Fleet Science Center, Natural History Museum, and Boomers mini golf.

### **"UNDER THE SEA"**

### • Week 2: (July 17 to July 21)

A wet 'n wild week is in store for campers as they dive deep into marine biology. Campers will splash around with water safety skills and water sports, and submerge into the ocean ecosystem to study puny plankton and tiny sea stars, as well as giant squid and humongous blue whales.

Field trips are contemplated to the Sea World, Alga Norte Aquatic Center, and the Wave Waterpark.

# **"CLEVER CARNIVORES"**

#### • Week 3: (July 24 to July 28)

"Clever Carnivores" Week will get campers up close and personal with ferocious felines, boisterous bears, ravaging raptors, cagy canines, dinosaurs, and other fearsome meat-eaters that sport night vision, sharp teeth, powerful jaws, amazing leaping abilities, and stealthy stalking behaviors.

Field trips contemplated include Glow Zone, Butterfly Sanctuary, and the San Diego Maritime Probable field trips include Lions, Tigers, and Bears in Alpine and the San Diego Safari Park.

### **"RADICAL NAUTICAL NAVIGATION"**

#### • Week 4: (July 31 to August 4)

Set course for a fun filled week learning about sea lanes and sailing, and what it takes to navigate like a captain or firstmate. Campers will learn to find their way with compasses and constellations, and the advantages and disadvantages of wind-driven and motorized crafts. Maritime merriment continues with a trip to see some real ships and a radical remote control boat race!
