"CALLING ALL ENGINEERS & CRAFTY INNOVATORS!"

● Week 1: (July 8 to July 12)

Welcome to Week 1 of RadCampz, which will focus on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math). We will design and create things in our very own Makers Space. Campers will have a myriad of games to play and puzzles to solve and things to build. We let creativity rule with LEGO challenges and fun tasks to problem solve, before bringing the resulting solutions to life. Some of the possible field trips include: The Ruben H. Fleet Science Center, The Automotive Museum, The Discovery Cube, and Pennypickle's Workshop. On Friday, campers will glide into the weekend on our 19 foot high "Rainforest Rapids" and 27' "Hurricane" water slides!

"WAVES OF WONDER"

● Week 2: (July 15 to July 19)

Welcome aboard Week 2 of RadCampz. This week campers will focus on amazing Marine Life, including vertebrates and invertebrates, as they explore the world's numerous ocean habitats. Then they will embark on two awesome field trips to "wet their fins" and learn about all things Aquatic. On Tuesday they will cool off at the Alga Norte Swim Center, and on Thursday they will venture to Sea World. On Wednesday and Friday, campers will glide and splash on, not one, but two of our on-campus, super fun water slides!

"SURF & SAFARI"

● Week 3: (July 22 to July 26)

Welcome to Week 3 of RadCampz, focused on animals of all kinds ...but mostly carnivores. Campers will enjoy activities, crafts, and experiments on the wild side. We will journey on two exciting field trips: On Tuesday, we'll splash down awesome water slides and then get tubular on the surf simulator at The Wave waterpark. On Thursday, it's off to see Lions and Tigers and bears OH MY! at the San Diego Safari Park. On Friday, campers will glide into the weekend on our 27 feet high "Hurricane" and 17' "Rainforest Rapids" water slides!

"HEROES, LEGENDS, & MYTHICAL MARVELS"

● Week 4: (July 29 to August 2)

Welcome to Week 4 of RadCampz, focused on all things fantastic and magical! We'll have fun with our favorite comic book heroes, wondrous wizards, and other favorite fictional characters from books and movies. Field trips contemplated for Tuesday and Thursday include: The San Diego Maritime Museum to peer into the lives of pirates and one of the newest animated movies. On Wednesday and Friday campers will glide on our thrilling Hurricane and Rainforest Rapid water slides.

"ASTRO AVIATORS & GALACTIC EXPLORERS"

● Week 5: (August 5 to August 9)

During Week 4, Earthlings in RadCampz will focus on airplanes, rockets, and all things Space. They will lift-off into activities, crafts, and experiments that are out of this world. This week includes two exciting field trips: The San Diego Air and Space Museum or perhaps the Discovery Cube, then off to become "weightless" at Sky Zone or Alga Norte Swim center. On Wednesday and Friday, campers will slip and slide on our 27 feet high "Hurricane" and 17' Rainforest Rapids water slides.

Policies & Procedures

Registration

A Program Registration Form, and an Emergency Health Card, must be completed and signed by a parent/legal guardian/parent's authorized representative before a student will be admitted into any Campz program. Submit forms early to secure space for your student.

Hours When Campz are In Session

Camper Pick-up 3:00 to 3:30 pm

Monday Morning Check-in

Students must arrive between 8:00 and 8:45 am on Mondays to allow time to complete the check-in and orientation process for the week ahead.

Lunches

Campers must bring a bag lunch for each camp day, except when it is announced that pizza or BBQ lunch will be provided on a particular day.

Sibling Discounts

The discounted weekly or bundle rate for a sibling(s) is 5%, provided the sibling(s) is attending the same week(s) of ECDS Campz. Polestar summer programs are not included in the Campz sibling discount.

5-Week Bundle Pricing

A 5-Week Bundle purchase includes unlimited Before & After Camp Care, as well as admission to all five weeks of camp.

Before & After Campz Care

Begins as early as 7:30 am and ends as late as 6:00 pm. \$16 per hour a la carte, \$195 per week unlimited.

Dress Guidelines

- Students attending a single week of Variety Campz, RadCampz, or Odyssey Campz will be issued one shirt and one hat on their first day of camp. Students pre-paying for two or more weeks of camp during a summer session will receive a second shirt. Extra shirts and hats are available for \$12 each.

- For safety and other reasons, students are required to wear a camp-issued shirt each day of camp. If students arrive without their camp shirt, they will be issued one and their parents will be charged \$12.

- Students must wear athletic, closed-toe shoes for Campz and Before & After Camp Care. Closed-toe athletic sandals such as certain models made by Keen, Teva, etc. also qualify as acceptable footwear. Crocs are not permitted.

Splash Days & Beach Days

Splash Day is a weekly tradition for many Campz based at ECDS. Inflatable "jumpies" and water slides are deployed and students are supervised by Campz staff members while playing on this equipment.

An off-site Beach Day excursion is sometimes offered as an alternative to an on-site Splash Day experience, for students attending RadCampz or Odyssey Campz.

On Splash or Beach Days, students can either bring their bathing suits to change into, or they can wear them under their clothes. They are still required to wear closed-toe shoes throughout the day before and after water play, but they may wear sandals when walking to and from the water slide or to and from the Campz transportation vehicle and the beach.

Students should pack a towel and dry clothes/underwear to change into after water play. Rash guards / UV protection sun shirts are recommended. Please apply sunscreen to your child before dropping them off at camp each day...especially on Splash and Beach Days.



Transportation

No transportation to or from a student's home is offered at this time. For off-site field trips and excursions, campers will be transported in safe, seat-belted ECDS vehicles driven by staff members, parent-driven carpools, or professional-driven chartered buses.

Absence Policy

Tuition fees for Campz are paid in consideration for a place in ECDS summer camp programs. No refunds or credit accrue to students who are absent during weeks they are enrolled in ECDS Campz.

As a courtesy to instructors and fellow students, we ask that parents of students who will not be attending a particular day of camp call the Campz Office (760-942-1111) the day before or morning of the day their child will be absent.

Refund Policy

No cash refunds will be considered beyond 72-hours after the Program Registration Form and tuition payment are received by ECDS.

Program Cancellations/Changes

ECDS Campz and related excursion may be canceled, rescheduled or modified due to insufficient enrollment, or unexpected limitations of weather, destination, scheduling, staffing, or transportation. In the event a cancellation or change is necessary, ECDS will make a concerted effort to accommodate registered campers with alternate programs, destinations or activities.
